Where applications do not call for an electronic display, we offer a paper directory insert that has all the features of the Infinity without the LCD display. And when additional doors or gates need to be controlled without the telephone entry needs, the Infinity "B" is utilized as a standard access control panel. Infinity systems allow for the entire 2000 name directory to be scrolled in less than 10 seconds. Locating the individual is easy since names are automatically placed in alphabetical order as they are entered. The names and phone numbers can

Each Infinity control panel can support card and code access for two doors or gates. An Infinity can be networked with other Infinity panels allowing support of up to 32 card readers for securing other access control entrances, such as a lobby door or vehicle entrance. The Infinity "S" (small display) contains a 2-line 16 character LCD display. The top line lists the intended party's name and the bottom line the directory code to enter. Once entered, the Infinity will check the programmed memory for the corresponding phone number and initiate the call. Once the call is answered, the resident presses the "9" key (or 5) to authorize access, or can hang up to deny the request. The Infinity "M" (medium display) is identical to the "S" except the LCD display supports 2 lines with 20 oversized characters in length.

The Infinity "L" (large display) boasts a patented LCD display allowing 24 names per page with 13 characters each, or 12 names using 35 characters. Regardless of the selected format, the names are easy to view because of the oversized characters and a very bright backlight.

When a paper directory already exists or is all that is needed, the Infinity DI (directory insert) includes all the features and capacities of the Infinity systems but without the LCD display.







The Infinity "B" can be integrated with other Infinity Telephone Entry Systems or installed separately to control all your access needs. The "B" panel has an optional LCD display internal to the enclosure for local programming.

All units, except the "B", include a stainless steel faceplate. The "B" panel offers it as an option. With a stainless steel faceplate, your unit can be installed inside or outside because the faceplate is engineered to withstand harsh weather conditions and vandalism. Regardless of the unit chosen, all features and functions are identical.

If an entry point has been forced open or the door held open beyond a pre-determined length of time, the panel can be configured to initiate an alarm call to a central station. Other enhanced features included in the Infinity Systems are time zone control for cardholder and access code usage, automatic gate or door lock/unlock cycles, access code restriction by number of uses, elevator control, and CCTV.

Access Levels

Allows entry codes or cardholders to be grouped by access points and time zones, using full control. The system supports unlimted levels to control access.

Time Zones

With full control, up to 8 time zones, 7 with 3 start and stop intervals each, are used for system functionality, such as automatic door/gate unlock or restricted personnel access.

Anti-Passback

Anti-passback prevents the possibility of an access code or card from being used by a second person at the same door. Two types of anti-passback are available: Timed and True. "Timed" waits for a pre-programmed period of time and "True" forces the user to use an exit reader before entering again.

Auto-Expiration Date

A visitor's card or entry code can be configured, using SPS WIN, with an expiration date that automatically disables the user from any future access based on that date.

Use-Limited Codes

Using SPS WIN, card or entry codes can be automatically disabled after a pre-determined amount of valid entries.

Burglar Alarm Shunt

A relay can be configured to trigger when an access request has been authorized. The relay is wired directly to the externally monitored burglar alarm panel.

Full-Duplex Communications

Provides crisp clear audio in both directions without clipping, even in most noisy environments.

Entry Codes

Each resident can be assigned a 4 or 5 digit access code that is used to unlock the gate or door.

Long Distance and PBX Dialing

Due to the amount of area codes in a single region, many areas are updating from a 7 digit dialing sequence to 10 and 11 digit sequences. The Infinity supports up to 11 digits on a typical phone system and interfaces seamlessly to a PBX system where extensions are utilized. Up to a 6-digit extension can be used for PBX type systems.

Tone/Pulse Dialing

Each system can be site configured to operate on the two types of available phone lines.

Variable Code Length

The Infinity will accept up to a 5-digit directory code length so apartments or suite numbers can be matched making it easier to locate the intended party.

Programmable Talk Time

The time allotted for a visitor and tenant to talk is adjustable from 15 to 250 seconds.

Shared Phone Line Capability

Multiple Infinity panels can be connected to a single telephone line saving you the cost of additional phone line charges. Up to 3 units may be placed on the same line.

Controllable System Relays

Allows the main gate and an auxiliary connection (a second gate or door) to be controlled, such as opened to let a visitor enter. The relays can be remotely managed from a manager's touch-tone phone and can be latched open or closed.

Programmable Relay Times

The two relays can also be programmed to activate for a pre-determined time range of 1 to 63 seconds.

Internal Modem
